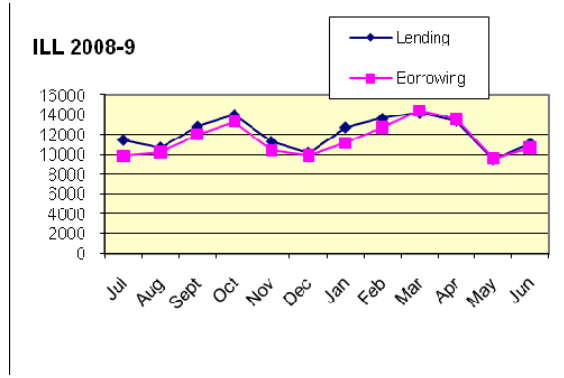
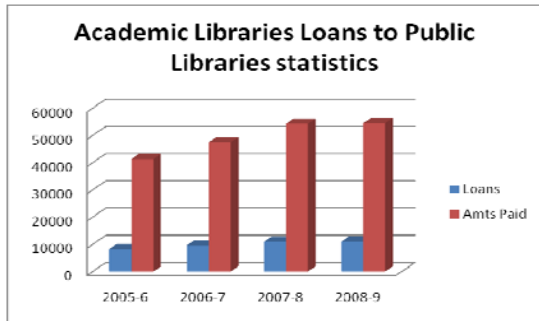


Resource Sharing

Several public, academic and special libraries in Arizona are a part of AzNet and resource share with each other at no charge. The Arizona State Library also encourages resource sharing by paying for small rural libraries to do retro-conversion of their collection and to upload their catalog holding to WorldCat. The State Library also pays for libraries in the state to access to WorldCat and encourages Academic Libraries to share their resources by subsidizing their loans to Public Libraries.
