

## Tribal Consulting

Library Development assisted the Indian Nations in several ways. Staff worked with each of the tribes, the following summarizes that work:

- Eligible tribal libraries received \$2,500 to purchase books for their libraries. To expedite the process of ordering books, accounts were established Baker & Taylor in order for each library to work directly with the vendor to order books. The Arizona State Library was invoiced for all book purchases. Participating libraries included the following tribal communities: Ak-Chin, Cocopah, Colorado River Indian Tribe, San Lucy (District of Tohono O'Odham Tribe), Ft. McDowell, Hopi, Whiteriver, Cibecue, and McNary.
- Assistance was provided in coordinating the 8<sup>th</sup> Gathering of Tribal Libraries which was held at the San Xavier Indian Community.
- In 2010, ten tribes received IMLS Basic grants and one tribe received an Enhanced Grant for \$150,000. The tribes include: Ak-Chin Indian Community, Cocopah Tribe, Colorado River Indian Tribe, Ft. McDowell Yavapai Nation, Gila River Indian Community, Hopi Tribe, Hualapai Indian Tribe, Pascua Yaqui Tribe, White Mountain Apache Tribe, and the Yavapai-Prescott Tribe. The Hopi Tribe received a \$150,000 enhance grant for a mobile computer technology lab.
- Assistance was provided to the Venito Garcia Tribal Library in submitting their annual statistics.
- Assistance was provided to the new librarian at the San Juan Paiute Tribal Library. The librarian received information about various library resources and opportunities.
- Tribal library continued their participation in the Library Summer Institute.
